With timeless classics such as "Danny Boy" and "Love is a Voyage", John's rich voice transcends classical and contemporary music into a riveting and joyous celebration!

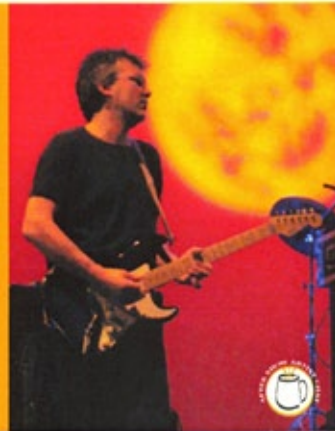

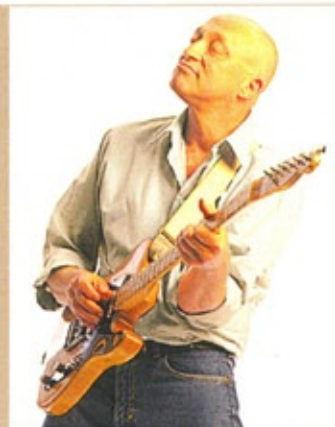
